## ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

- Complete a Bevill State **APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION** and submit it to the Office of Student Services. You may apply online or download a printed application at [www.bscc.edu](http://www.bscc.edu).
- Request a copy of your official transcript from high school and any college(s) you have previously attended. If you received a GED, request your official GED transcript through Student Services.
- To be considered for most types of financial assistance, you must first complete the **FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)** which is available online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). Bevill State's Financial Aid Code is 005733.
  - Include an e-mail address (if you have one) on the FAFSA form.
  - You must obtain a PIN (electronic signature) at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov) to sign your FAFSA electronically. Dependent students' parents must obtain a PIN to sign FAFSA electronically.
  - After you file a FAFSA, Bevill State will email or mail a letter to you when we receive your financial information from the federal government, which may take approximately ten business days. The letter will include instructions to complete your financial aid file.
  - All recipients of federal funds must complete a **DISBURSEMENT PROCEDURE FORM** for the applicable year which is found at [www.bscc.edu](http://www.bscc.edu) - Financial Aid - Forms, Publications, and Applications. Print the form, read and sign.
  - Submit all completed financial aid documents to the Office of Student Services.
  - Financial aid students must have a declared program of study to receive financial aid.
  - Once your file is complete you will be considered for any other financial awards for which you may be eligible.
  - For Federal Work Study and/or scholarship information, contact the Office of Student Services.
- Once you have been admitted to Bevill State, you may view your awards or records required to complete your Financial Aid and/or Admissions Record at [www.bscc.edu](http://www.bscc.edu) - myBSCC. Your login is your student number and your default password is your date of birth in mmddyy format.
- Schedule an appointment with the Testing Center to take the COMPASS placement exam. After you complete the placement exam, you will be assigned an academic advisor.
- Contact your academic advisor. Your advisor will answer any questions you may have about your chosen program of study, review a degree plan, and assist you with registration for the upcoming semester.

**NOTE: When you register, you must pay all charges in order to be officially registered.**
