Apply for the Free Application for Financial Aid (FAFSA) online at www.studentaid.gov
 □ You must obtain a FSA ID at www.studentaid.gov to complete your FAFSA. □ Dependent students' parents must also obtain a FSA ID to complete the FAFSA electronically.
☐ Include an e-mail address on the FAFSA if you have one.
☐ The Federal School Code is <u>005733</u> for ALL CAMPUSES of Bevill State Community College.
☐ After filing a FAFSA, the Financial Aid Services Central Processing Center (FASCPC) will email you upon receipt of the FAFSA information with instructions to complete your financial aid file.
If you have been selected for verification, you must submit the appropriate Verification Worksheet and, when appropriate, you and your parents' IRS Tax Return Transcripts if you did not use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA. You may request a copy of your 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript from the IRS website (www.irs.gov) if you filed taxes. The tax transcript request takes approximately 5-10 days for processing.
Submit completed documents to your local Office of Student Services (OSS) or the address below to complete the Pell Grant process.
All students receiving Federal financial aid must maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined in the <i>Bevill State Community College Catalog</i> .
All financial aid students must have a declared major/program of study to receive financial aid.
All final high school or GED transcripts are required for students without a Baccalaureate degree.
All college transcripts are required for all transfer students.
It is the responsibility of the student to make sure his/her admission and financial aid records are complete before any type of financial aid can be used. Your award is not final until all requested information is submitted.
Once your file is complete, you will be considered for any other awards for which you may be eligible.
For Federal Work Study and/or scholarships, please contact OSS personnel at your campus.
