POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

POSITION #766: Part Time Bus Driver (on as needed basis) – Must be available during weekdays, weekends, and potentially overnight stays

GENERAL INFORMATION: Bevill State Community College is an accredited, learning-centered institution dedicated to student success by providing quality educational and training opportunities that enrich lives intellectually, economically, and culturally.

QUALIFICATIONS: High School diploma or GED required. Experience in maintaining Bus units is preferred. Current Commercial Driver's License (CDL A with passenger endorsement) is required.

SALARY RANGE: Up to ½ day - \$115 Whole day – 9 hours - \$200 Out of town and over 9 hours (early morning to late evening) – day and ½ rate - \$225 - \$250

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS: The position of Part time Bus Driver requires the following essential job functions with or without reasonable accommodations: communicate orally; communicate in writing; read and interpret; exhibit emotional control and stability; operate a motor vehicle; ability to lift and move materials weighing up to fifty pounds; sit for extended periods of time; stand for extended periods of time; capable of mobility; bend; kneel; reach; ascend and descend steps; utilize telephone system. Comply with all policies of the Alabama Community College System, Board of Trustees and the College.

DUTIES: In addition to adhering to the guidelines as specified by *Bevill State Community College Personnel Handbook* and the Alabama Community College System, duties will include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Operate the College bus in a safe and effective manner to minimize the risk of injury, property damage or loss of life.
2. Pick up and deliver employees, students, and guests as per a schedule.
3. Operate the bus in a safe and efficient way according to all relevant legislation, policies, and procedures.
4. Perform safety and maintenance checks.
5. Clean the bus as scheduled and/or required.
6. Ensure the bus is safely and securely stored.
7. Advise appropriate personnel of any requirements for maintenance or repairs.
8. Maintain trip logs, gas receipts and any service receipts.
9. Maintain pre and post trip logs.
10. Collect directions and know trip routes well.
11. Stay alert in bad traffic and/or weather conditions.
12. Interact with passengers and maintain order on the bus.
13. Maintain professional conduct in dealing with students, staff, administration, faculty, and the college community.
14. Maintain Class A license with a passenger, double/triple, and tank endorsements. Endorsements must be obtained before third-party testing school.
15. Ability to sit for extended periods of time.
16. Assist in enforcing all college policies.
17. Assume all other duties as assigned by Fleet Supervisor.

- Complete transcripts from **every** institution from which **any** collegiate credit has been earned. Transcripts **must** include conferred or awarded date.
- A resume.
- **No staples or paper clips.**

Employment will be contingent upon the receipt of a clearance notification from the criminal background check.
