An area of emphasis must include the following:

- *All the requirements to satisfy the minor in that department*
 - *At least 12 hours of 300- or 400- level courses*
 - *A minimum grade of "C" on all courses in the area*
- * *No more than one-half of your degree may be community college hours (60 hours).*
 * *At least 120 semester hours with passing grades must be completed for any Liberal Arts degree.*
 * *Choose electives carefully to make sure that a minimum of 40 hours of course work--at least one-third of the hours applied toward a degree--is at the 300-level or above.*
 * *You must attain a GPA of 2.00 or better on all work attempted, as well as all work attempted at The University of Mississippi.*
